



<b>Problem</b>	<b>Recommended Solution</b>
Dirt & Grime	Sweep & Spray decking with a down with high pressure water hose
Water Spots	Clean with a deck cleaner containing Oxalic Acid, such as Floods Dekswood®. <a href="http://www.floodco.com">www.floodco.com</a>
Leaf Stains	Clean with a deck cleaner containing Oxalic Acid
Oil & Grease Stains	Rinse stains and scrub with a household degreasing cleaner. For severe grease stains use : Oil & Grease Stain Remover <a href="http://www.psc-solutions.com">www.psc-solutions.com</a> or 800-354-2926
Rust Stains	Use a deck cleaner containing Oxalic Acid. Allow product to work on stain for 10- 15 minutes. Then rinse with warm water
Chalk Line	All Chalk lines are permanent except white. We recommend using a white chalk line only
Ice & Snow Removal	Apply calcium chloride or rock salt; use a plastic shovel to avoid gouging the surface. Later rinse deck to avoid surface residue build up
Mold & Mildew	Periodically cleaning your deck to prevent build up of pollen, dirt & grime, even if the deck appears clean  Use a deck cleaner containing Sodium Hypochlorite such as Thompson's or Olympic Deck washes. For moderate to severe mold staining use: Composite Deck Restorer and Composite Deck Afterclean Available from Problem Solving Corporation 800-354-2926 or <a href="http://www.psc-solutions.com">www.psc-solutions.com</a>
Ink	Ink stains may be permanent. The stains may be lightened by cleaning with household detergent and warm water
